- To talk to someone who has aphasia, you just need to communicate differently.

### **Communication Tips**

• Ask 1 question at a time.



Pen and paper helps. Write down key words.



• Hear him or her out! Do not rush them.



- Allow enough time to respond.
- Slow down. Speak clearly.



Incorporate drawings, pictures, and gestures



Ask. Wait. Listen!
