

The workers compensation program covers a variety of service areas including:

INPATIENT REHABILITATION

- Brain injury
- Spinal cord injury
- Chronic pain including opioid wean
- Major multiple trauma
- Physician consultations available, regardless of location
- Single point of contact via a Workers Compensation Care navigator
- Ventilator unit and diaphragmatic pacing system program
- Helen's House - A nonprofit hospitality house offering affordable temporary lodging to patients and their caregivers
- Costly hospitalizations are avoided with an **82 percent rate** of discharge to community (**national average is 67 percent**)
- Ranked in the top **10 percent of all freestanding rehabilitation facilities** for **patient satisfaction**

SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- **Brooks Cybernic Treatment Center:** The only US-based facility offering CYBERDYNE's Medical Hybrid Assistive Limb (HAL) technology to those with a spinal cord injury. HAL is the world's first robotic medical device that has been shown to improve a patient's ability to walk.
- **Neuro Recovery Center:** State-of-the-art rehabilitation centers featuring advanced equipment and technology to benefit individuals with neurological injuries or illnesses.
- **Pain Rehabilitation Program:** This interdisciplinary and biopsychosocial program is offered in inpatient or outpatient settings for injured workers with chronic pain. It has excellent documented clinical outcomes and significantly reduces long-term health care costs. Inpatient or outpatient opioid wean is also a component of the program.
- **Neurorehabilitation Day Treatment Program:** A program to help individuals with acquired brain injury regain independence to return to work and driving while reducing attendant care.
- **Comprehensive Functional Evaluation (CFE):** A workers comp specific, multi-day, interdisciplinary evaluation designed to assist with case closure for complicated cases.
