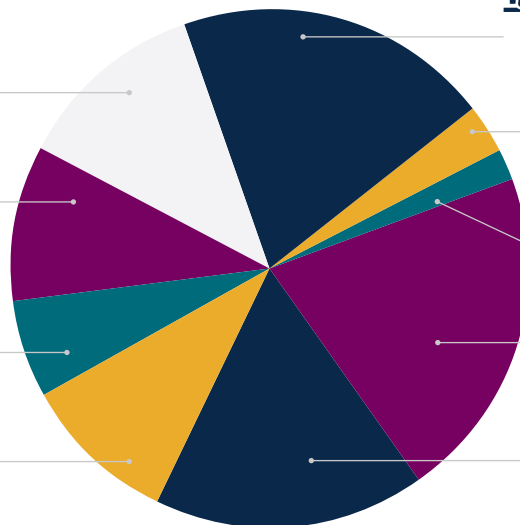

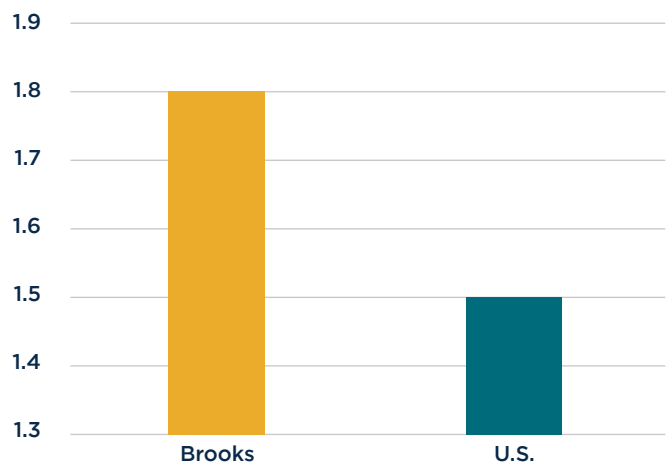
Brooks Physicians are Distinctly Trained Specialists
