**Being discharged from a rehabilitation hospital or a skilled nursing facility to home can cause some uneasiness or feelings of insecurity.**

- Our Brooks Rehabilitation team is available to ensure your care continues at home and that you get home with all the necessary services and resources.
- One of our Brooks Center for Care Transitions team members will call you to help you enroll in our program and to schedule your rehab medicine telehealth visit.
- These calls and this virtual telehealth visit provides you and a family member an opportunity to let us know how you are doing. By virtually visiting with a care provider (over a secure connection that we help you obtain), we will help ensure you are safe and also have what you need to remain home.
- Please be sure to answer our calls so we can help you with your transition to home
