Do you have an incomplete Spinal Cord Injury? Do you have difficulty walking? Are you a man >18 years old?

If so, you may be able to participate in a study at the VA Medical Center (Gainesville, FL) and Brooks Rehabilitation (Jacksonville, FL).

We are assessing if testosterone therapy and locomotor (walking) training improve muscle & bone health and walking ability in men with low testosterone and problems walking after spinal cord injury (SCI).



If you meet criteria and enroll, you may receive testosterone injections for 6 months. You may also receive locomotor training for 2-3 months or you may be in a group that receives no treatment. You will undergo tests to measure your muscle & bone health, walking ability, and other markers of health and physical function.
