"Train Your Brain!"

Do you sometimes have trouble with your thinking or memory?

Researchers at University of Florida and Brooks Rehabilitation are testing an experimental treatment that may improve both cognitive ability and walking ability.

Study participants will undergo a 6-week walking exercise program combined with mild electrical stimulation of the brain.



This study involves:

- Tests of cognitive ability (thinking and memory) and walking ability
- Mild electrical stimulation of the brain
- Walking exercise 3 days/week for 6 weeks
- Brain imaging with MRI

You may qualify if you are:

- Age 65 or older
- Have some difficulty with thinking and/or memory
- Generally healthy, with no major disabling medical conditions
- Willing and able to travel to our research sites for the exercise and testing sessions

Qualified participants can receive up to \$750 for completion of the study.
