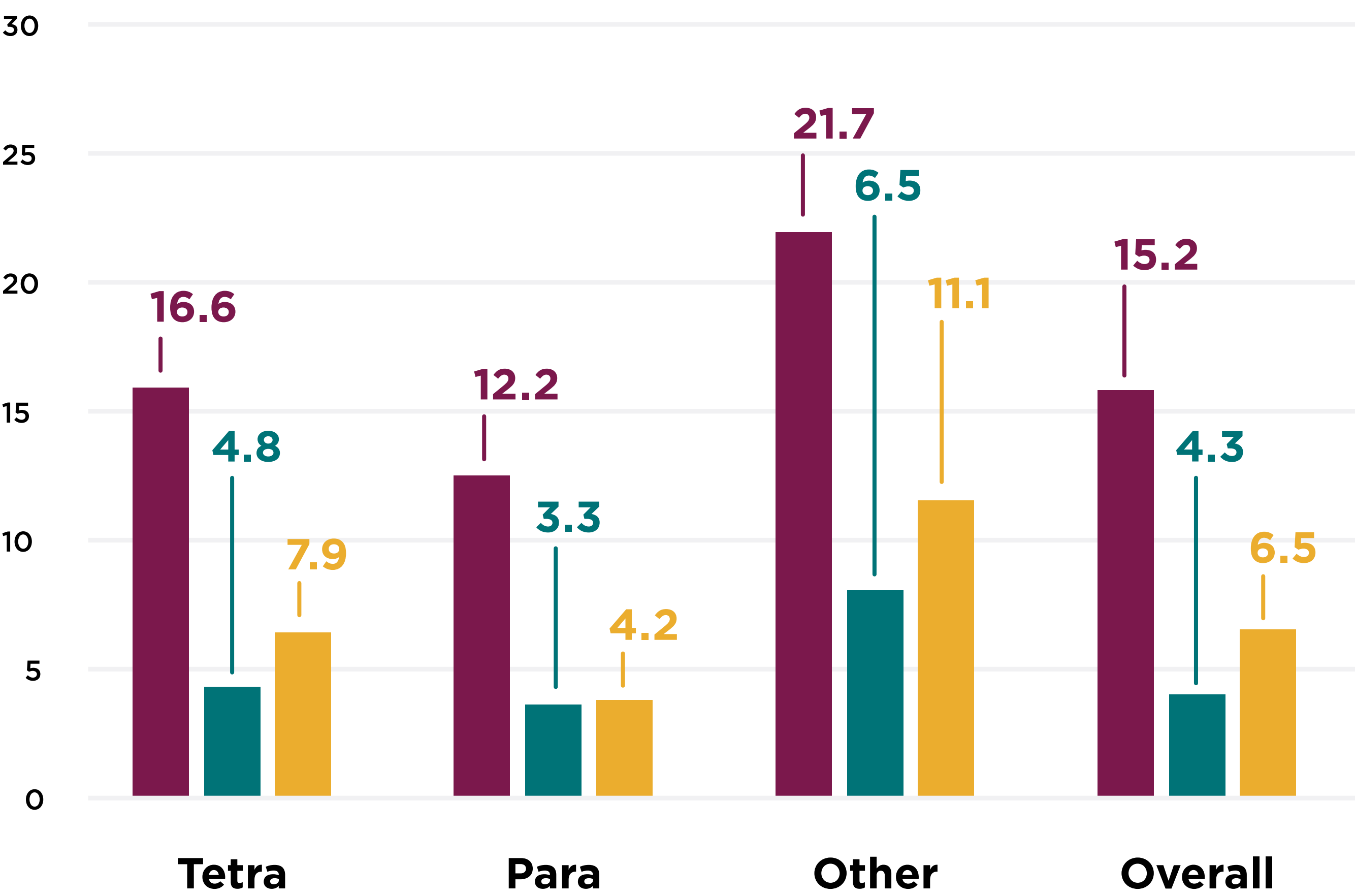


Spinal Cord Injury Independence Measure (SCIM) III

SCIM III is a 0-100 objective scale, with higher scores indicating greater independence, broken down into subscales for Self-Care, Mobility, Respiration & Sphincter Management (this item not included).
On the total score, a substantial improvement is considered a 10-point increase, serving as a benchmark to determine if a patient’s progress is truly meaningful.

Self-Reported Functional Measure (SRFM)

SRFM is a subjective disability scale developed to specifically address the ability of SCI patients to perform basic activities of daily living independently. Higher scores reflect higher levels of independence.
Based on statistical analysis, our patients demonstrate clinically meaningful improvement across all self-care domains from admission to discharge.
Our target of a 5 point change typically reflects improvement in multiple ADL tasks.
