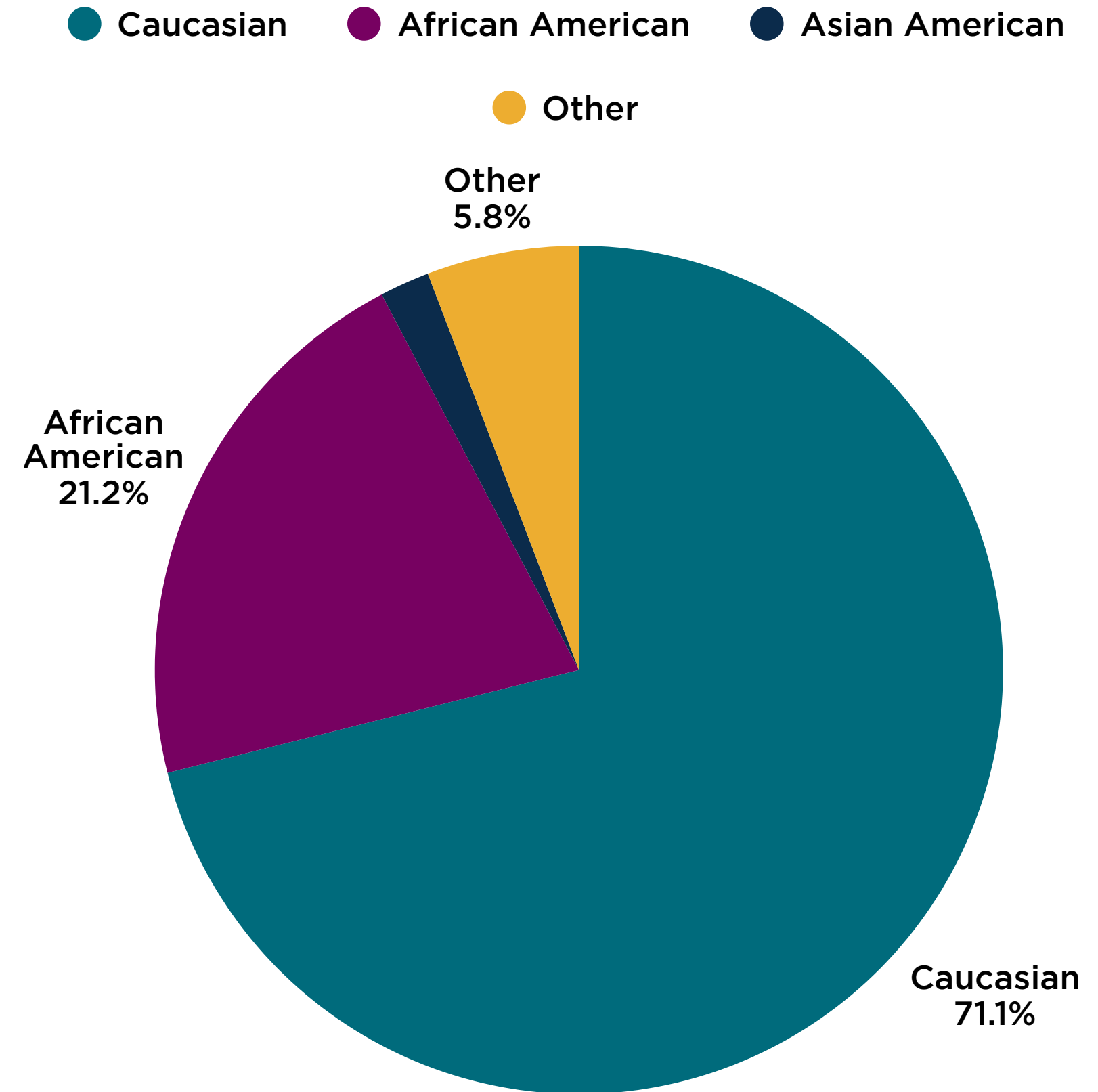

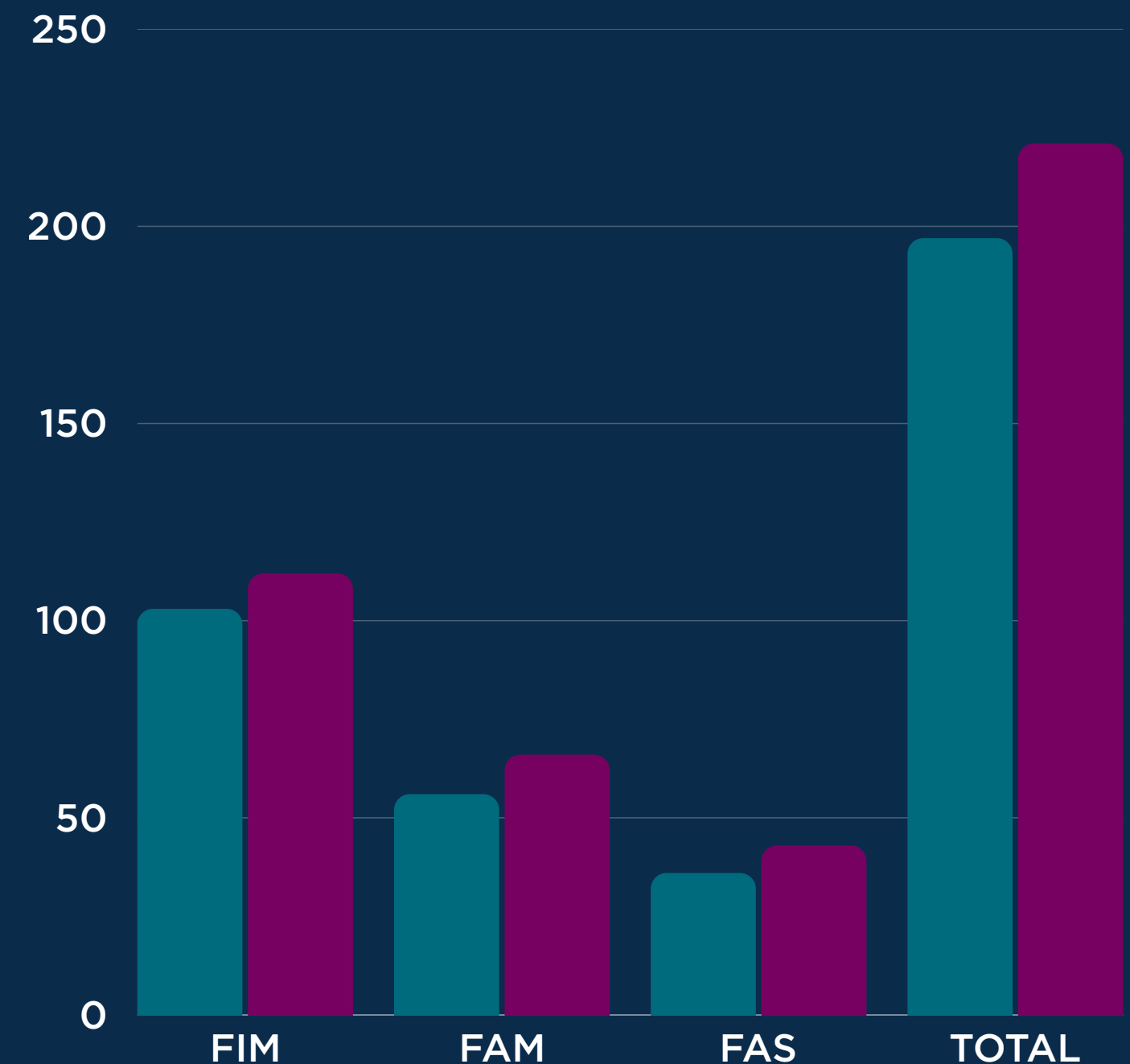

REDUCING IMPAIRMENTS/DISABILITIES:

TOTAL FIM/FAM/FAS SCORES SHOW  
SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENTS FROM  
ADMIT TO DISCHARGE ACROSS  
PHYSICAL, COGNITIVE, AND  
EMOTIONAL/PSYCHOSOCIAL  
VARIABLES (TOTAL 39 VARIABLES).

ADMIT AVERAGE: 196 / 273

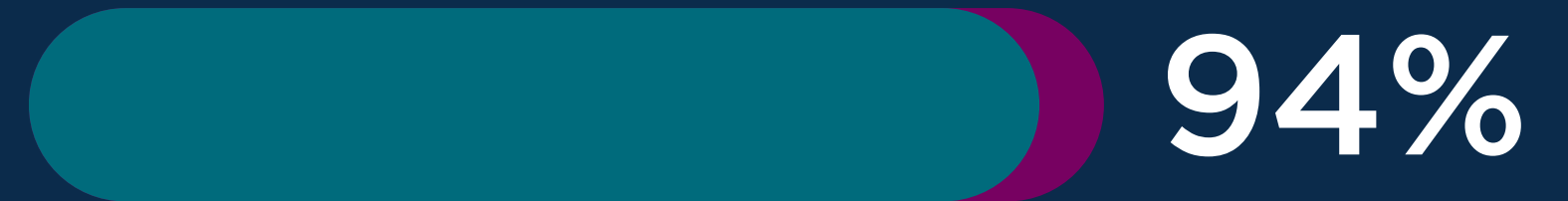

ACTUAL: 94%



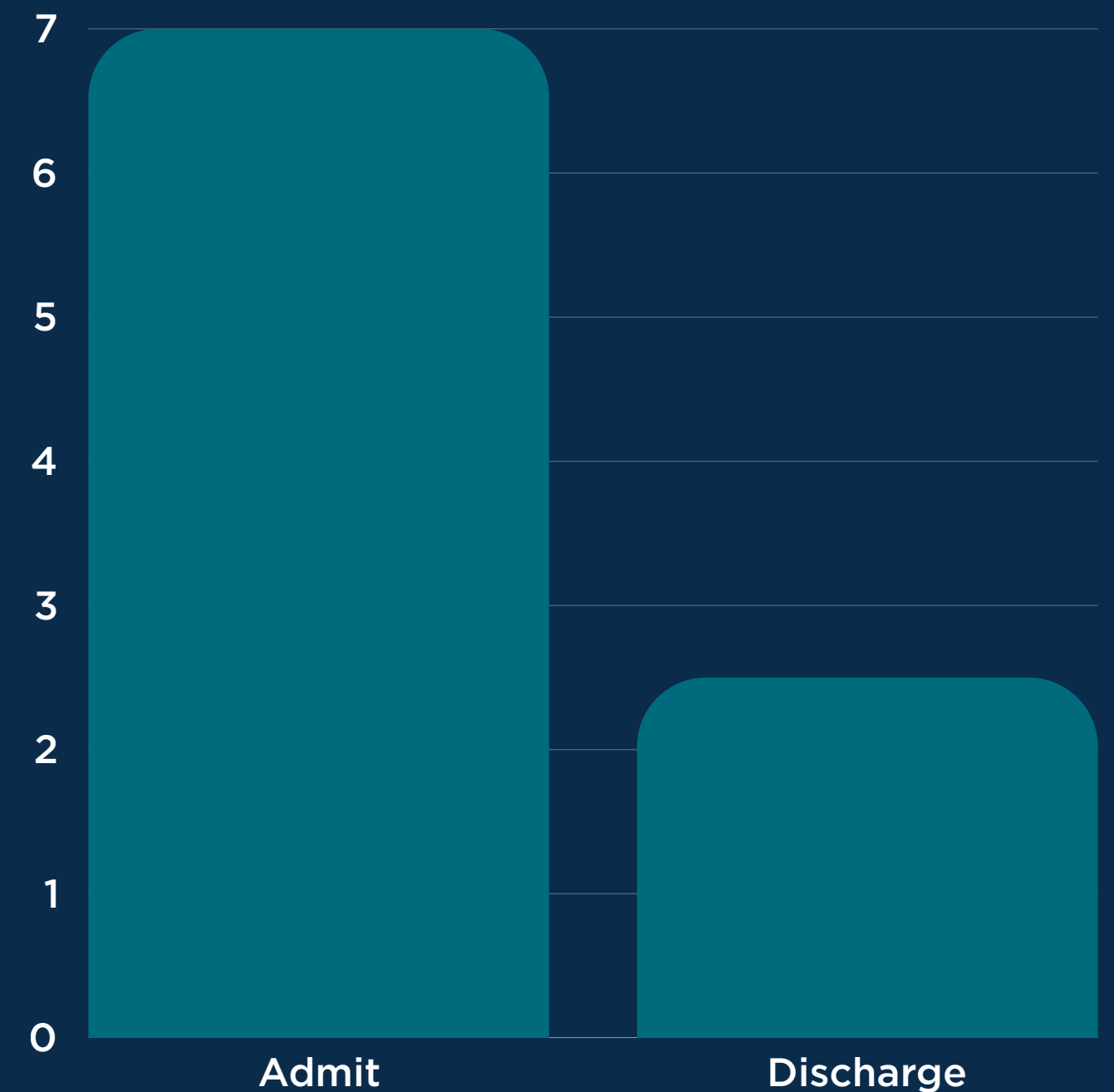

DISCHARGE: 2.4 / 30

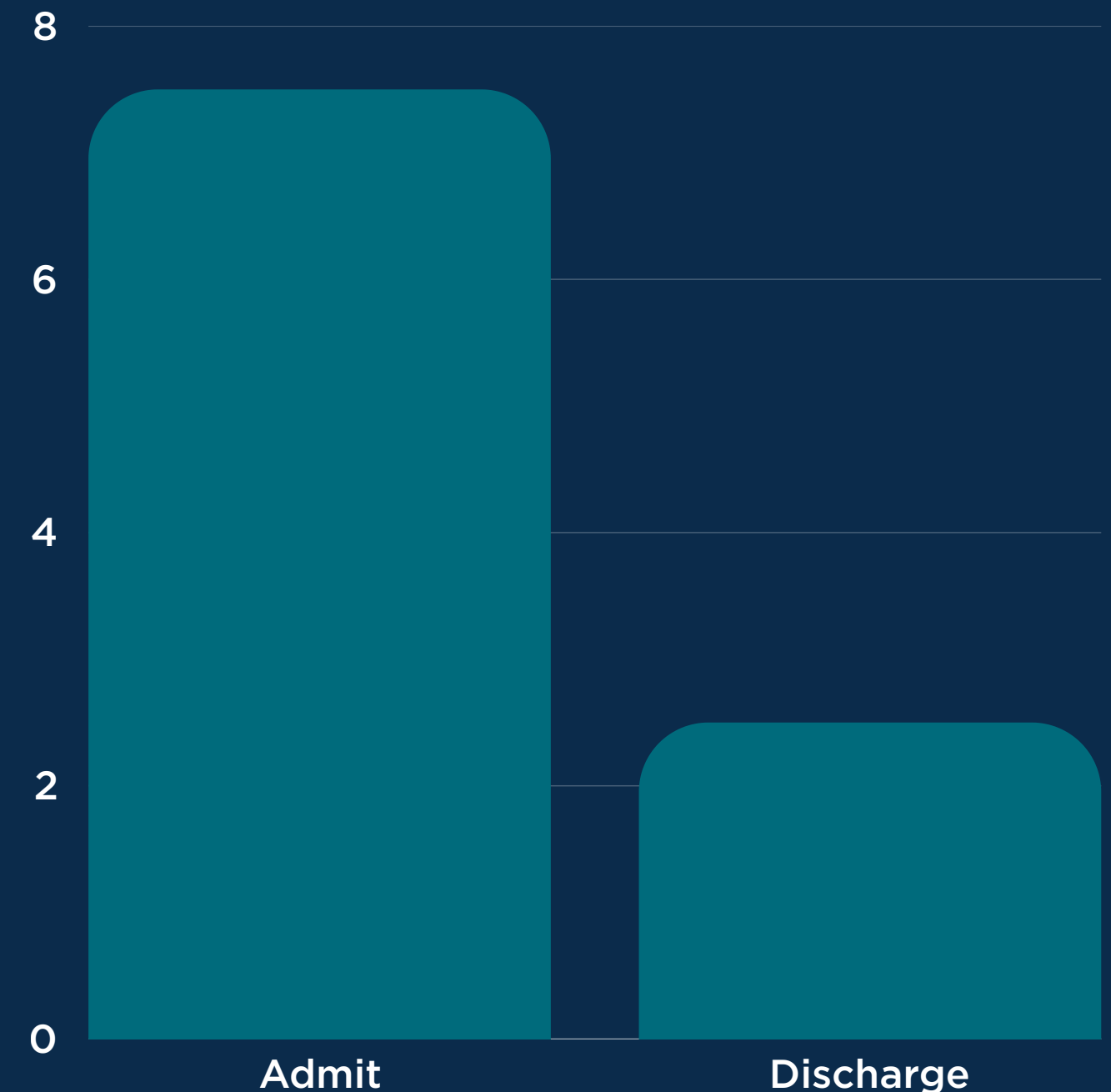


# SUPERVISION RATING SCALE

ADMIT: 7.3 / 13

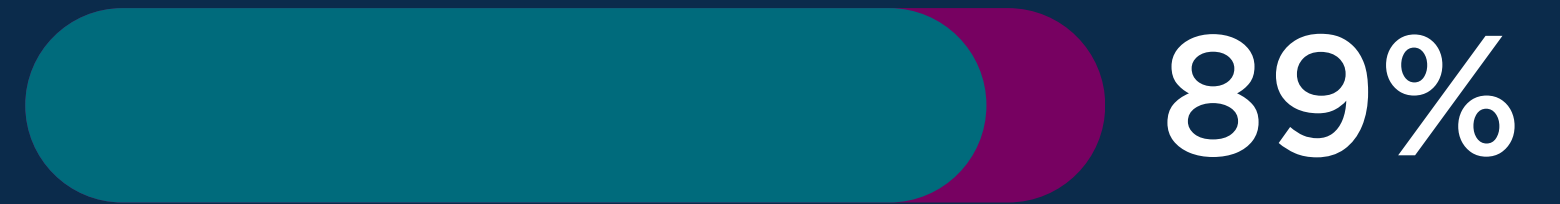
DISCHARGE: 1.9 / 13

DISCHARGE

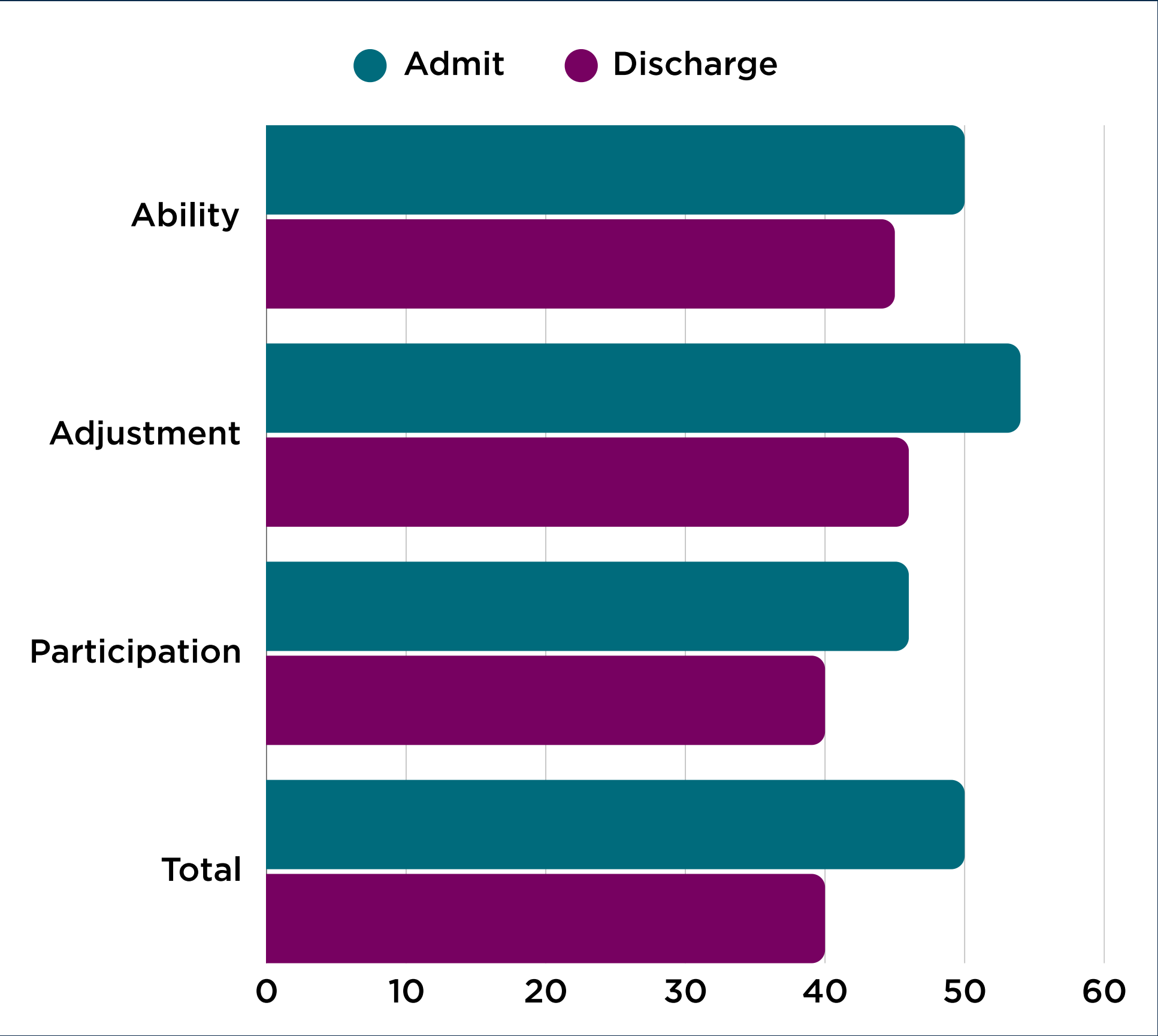
GOAL: 70%

FOLLOW UP

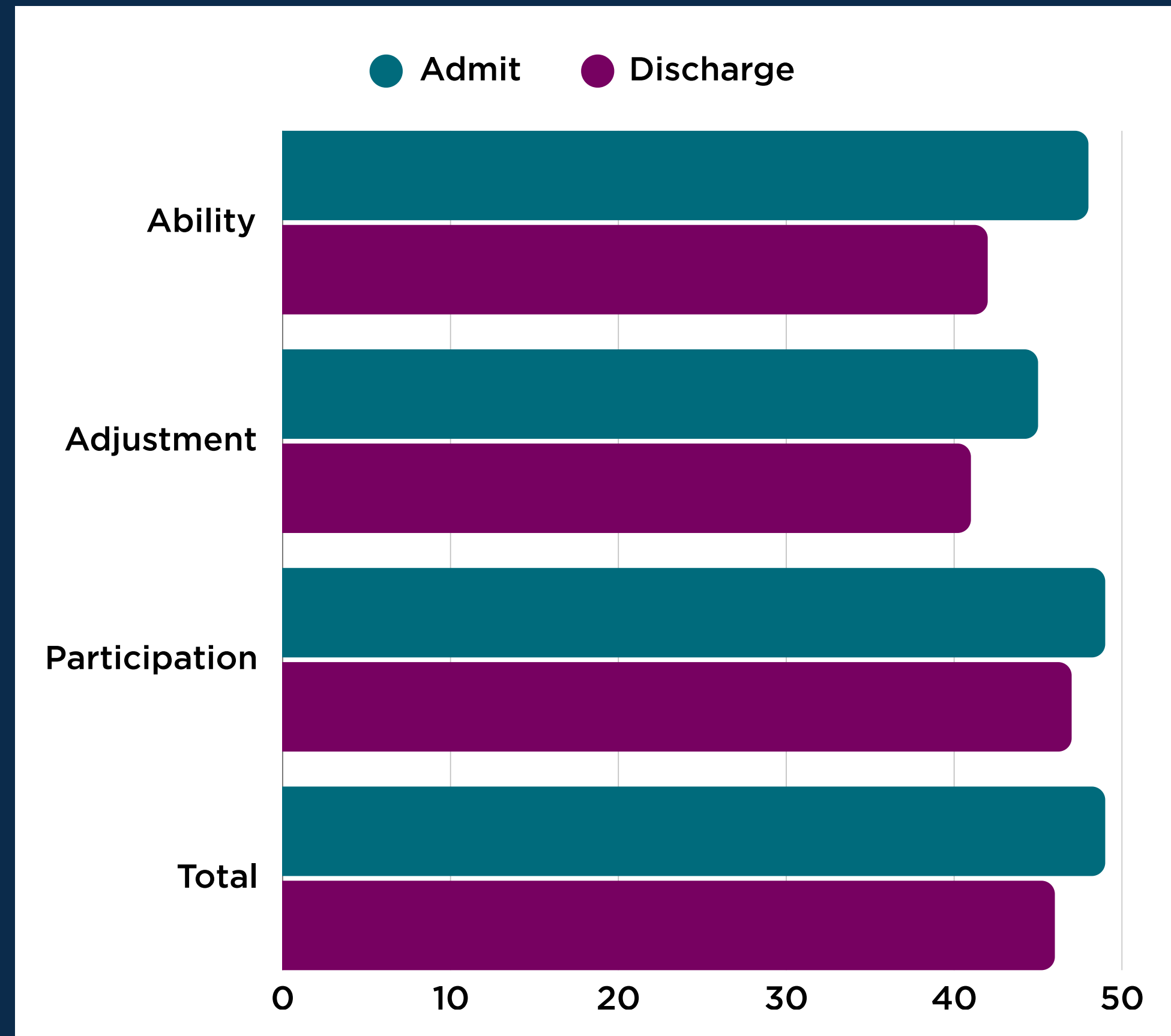
# MAYO-PORTLAND ADAPTABILITY INVENTORY (MPAI-4)

STAFF RATINGS  
T-SCORE (STANDARD SCORE): PATIENTS ARE DEMONSTRATING IMPROVEMENT IN FUNCTIONING ACROSS ALL THREE DOMAINS IN TERMS OF ABILITIES (I.E., MOBILITY, MEMORY), ADJUSTMENT (I.E., MOOD, AWARENESS), AND PARTICIPATION (I.E., LEISURE ACTIVITIES, SELF-CARE, EMPLOYMENT)



# MAYO-PORTLAND ADAPTABILITY INVENTORY (MPAI-4)

PATIENT RATINGS  
T-SCORE (STANDARD SCORE): PATIENTS  
ARE REPORTING IMPROVEMENT IN  
FUNCTIONING ACROSS ALL THREE DOMAINS  
IN TERMS OF ABILITIES (I.E., MOBILITY,  
MEMORY), ADJUSTMENT (I.E., MOOD,  
AWARENESS), AND PARTICIPATION (I.E.,  
LEISURE ACTIVITIES, SELF-CARE,  
EMPLOYMENT)



## MAYO-PORTLAND ADAPTABILITY SCALE (MPAI-4)

AWARENESS MEASURE: SCORES SUGGEST  
PATIENTS ARE IMPROVING THEIR  
AWARENESS FROM ADMISSION TO  
DISCHARGE. NOTE THE DISCREPANCY SCORE  
DECREASES FROM 24 POINTS AT THE TIME  
OF ADMISSION TO 14 POINTS AT THE TIME OF  
DISCHARGE.
